OFFICE CLOSED

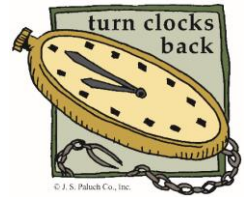
The office will be closed on Friday, November 10th for the Veteran's Day Holiday.



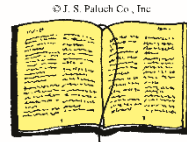
The office will also be closed on Thursday and Friday, November 23rd and 24th for the Thanksgiving Day Holiday.

Our Newman students are once again selling the beautiful God's Creation wall calendars for 2018. The calendars are \$10.00 each and they make a great gift for family and friends.

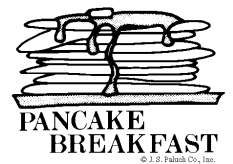

END OF LIFE ISSUES

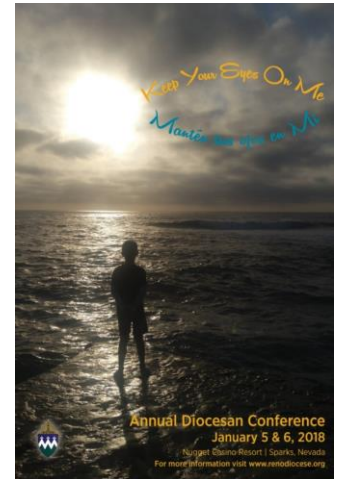
